### Inland Championship - Day One

Forty nine C-scows took the waters of Okoboji today to kick off the 2008 ILYA Inland Championship. One race was completed in the morning with no sailing in the afternoon. The fleet started Race One shortly after 10:30am. The course was a W2+ set at 035 degrees. Winds were lighter at 5 to 10 mph. The breeze swung a little left off the start as the boats on the port end jumped to the early lead. Marty Barr B-6 was your leader at the first mark. Things got very interesting on the first downwind. Large holes and "private" puffs resulted in a number of boats making big moves - forward and back. At the leeward mark Team Beulah was 1, 2, 3 - Barr, Kent Haeger B-12 and Brian Brickler B-18.

The second lap was full of more wind shifts. The race committee did a great job staying in front of the breeze. On the second upwind the breeze swung left some helping the boats on the left side of the course. Heading downwind the second time the breeze went back to the right. Most boats never gybed.

The final upwind Haeger took control and won Race One. Dale Norton P-9 and Jason Ostbye M-17 joined the Beulah three. Norton finished second, followed by Brickler, Ostbye and Barr.
