NCSSA National Championship Regatta

Day Two Results



Three races were sailed today in WNW breeze of 10 to 15mph. The theme of the day was starting - as in restarts - every race had at least one general recall or postponement. Race 5 had two generals under black flag. The fleet was working the race committee's patience today.

Race 3 was a W2+. A136, Ed Eckert, led the fleet around for most of the race. Ed went on to win followed by V11 (Augie Barkow), OO3 Leif Evensen, A14 (Paul Reilly), and D3 (Mark Hetzler).

Race 4 was also W2+ sailed back-to-back. N24 Craig Heinze led for most of that race, and was trailed closely two past champions; OO88 Peter Keck, and V137 Jim Gluek. The last time up wind Keck and Gluek got Heinze near the finish line. Keck first, Gluek second, Heinze third, Barkow fourth, and I113 Vincent Porter fifth.

The fleet broke for lunch. Standing through four races were:
