Regional Championships

The C fleet has a long history of Championship regattas. The ILYA Annual Championship for the C fleet goes back to 1906, but we also have a rich history in regional championships. These regattas and Associations parallel the history and tradition of our Annual Championship.

Inter-Lakes - Minnesota, Iowa and Missouri

The Inter-Lake Regatta began around 1895, pre-dating the formation of the ILYA, as a challenge regatta between the White Bear Yacht Club and the Minnetonka Yacht Club. At that time, the event was viewed as a major social and sporting event in the region. In the first few years of the regatta, the challenge alternated only between White Bear and Minnetonka. Boats were transported by rail and by horse drawn carts to the lakes. The best linens and silver were brought out and used at the regatta's social gatherings. Newspaper coverage of the racing was complete and extensive, and the whole regatta was a real highlight of the summer.

WYA - Wisconsin and Illinois

The Wisconsin Yachting Association was established in 1938 by three charter clubs, La Belle (originally known as the Oconomowoc Yacht Club), Okauchee, and Nagawicka. These clubs had held a successful regatta between their three lakes with skippers and crews enjoying the friendly rivalry. Wishing to make the regatta an annual event, the WYA was formed to advance good sportsmanship, increase sailing enjoyment and skills, and to promote yacht racing as one of the greatest and oldest sports in the world. Approximately 18 "C" scows competed in the first regatta. The WYA was destined to grow with Lake Beulah joining the Association in 1940 and Pewaukee Lake in 1942. Other lakes, realizing how the WYA was successfully achieving its goals, wished to join and in 1946 the Oconomowoc Lake Club was admitted, followed by Beaver Lake in 1947 and Pistakee Bay in 1948, rounding out the eight lake format.

WMYA - Michigan

2009 marks the 80th year of the Western Michigan Yachting

Association. The WMYA was formed in December 1929 as a result of an informal agreement between representatives of the three original member clubs; the Spring Lake Yacht Club, the Muskegon Yacht Club and the White Lake Yacht Club. They were joined one year later by Grand Rapids Yacht Club and the Torch Lake Yacht, and in 1938 Pentwater and Crystal Lake had also joined.
