50th C Scow Blue Chip Regatta

This weekend marks the 50th anniversary of the C Scow Blue Chip. An invitation to the Blue Chip regatta has long been an honored tradition for many C Scow sailors. This year is no different in that we've assembled the very best of the best from the National C Scow Sailing Association.
