- Venue:** Pewaukee Yacht Club,  
Pewaukee Lake

- Rules:** The races will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- Eligibility:** The regatta is open to Class C Scows. Helms-persons **MUST** be Regular Members and the 1<sup>st</sup> crew **MUST** be at least an Associate Member of the NCSSA. 3rds are not required to be members but are encouraged to be at least Associate Members. Eligible yachts may be entered by completing the registration form or may enter by registering online at [www.NCSSA.com](http://www.NCSSA.com).
- Advertising:** The regatta is designated as a Category A event in accordance with the ISAF Regulation 20.
- Registration:** The entry fee is \$130 until May 15, 2009 (post marked).  
The entry fee is \$150 from May 16 to June 10<sup>th</sup>  
The entry fee is \$170 from June 10<sup>th</sup> until the close of registration.
- For skippers under the age of 25 years (as of June 15, 2007),**  
The entry fee is \$60 until May 15, 2009 (post marked).  
The entry fee is \$75 from May 16 to June 10<sup>th</sup>  
The entry fee is \$90 from June 10<sup>th</sup> until the close of registration.

**Scoring:** The low point scoring system, RRS A4, shall apply. Six races are scheduled, of which three must be completed to constitute a series. A boat's worst score will be discarded if all six races are completed.

This changes RRS A2.
