Registration Schedule

Friday, June 7 5:00 – 8:00 PM – Registration, Check-in and Launch. Boats may be moored or dry sailed, space permitting

Saturday 7:00 – 9:00am – Registration, Check-in and Launch.

Saturday 9:30am – A competitor's briefing will take place at regatta headquarters.

Race Schedule

Five races are scheduled. The warning signal for the first race will be at 10:30am on Saturday, June 8. Except when races are sailed back-to-back, the approximate time of warning signals for subsequent races will be posted. One race constitutes a regatta. No warning signal will be made after Noon, Sunday June 9 if at least one race has been completed. In any case, no warning signal shall be made after 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 9.

Social Schedule

Lunches will be available daily at headquarters. Two lunches for Sat and Sun are included in registration. Extra lunches available for \$8.

Friday 5:00 p.m. – 11:00 pm – Join us at the bar.

Saturday Evening – Two tickets for a Saturday dinner are included in registration.

Additional Details

Fees

The entry fee is \$100 per boat. This includes lunches and party for two. Additional meals can be purchased at registration. Entry is \$0 for youth-aged skippers (age 25 and under as of January 1, 2019). Those who take advantage of this must be members of the NCSSA. A 4% credit card processing charge will be assessed.

Trophies

Trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew of the top five finishing boats.

Rules changes:

Rules: For the purpose of RRS41, the crew of a capsized boat or a crew member overboard should be considered “in danger” and thus eligible to continue racing after being helped or righted.

Housing

Attempt to house distant sailors will be made with advanced request.

Launching and Mooring: Available at Regatta Headquarters during registration hours.

Competitor trailer storage will be available off and on site. Instructions available at registration.

Mooring

Bring your own anchor, buoy and line (30 feet). Boats may be moored. All moorings must be removed on Sunday, June 9.

Spectator Fleet

Limited spectator boats will be available from regatta headquarters.
