Lake Maxinkuckee is the second largest natural lake in Indiana (spring fed), covering 1,864 acres or 2.9 mi². The average depth is 24 ft., max. 88 ft. The Town of Culver is located on its northwestern edge. Lake Max is a premier Scow sailing lake. It's large but not too large (1.5 x 2.5 miles), clean and without boat waves in September. It is a must-do on every scow sailor's bucket list.

Regatta HQ is at the Naval Building on the grounds of Culver Military Academy, a college prep school. The redbrick buildings on the New Englandesque, 1800-acre campus contain military touches like turrets and parapets. The chapel houses the second largest pipe organ and clarion in the United States. The Vaughn Equestrian Center has the largest indoor riding arena located on an academic campus. The 47,000 square foot library is one of the most modern secondary school libraries in the country.

Culver, IN is located 40 minutes from South Bend, IN, only 2 hours from Chicago, 2.5 hours from Grand Rapids and 3.5 hours from the Canadian border.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and the [Sailing Instructions](#).

Venue: The Culver Academies are college preparatory boarding schools on the north shore of Lake Maxinkuckee. Culver, Indiana is located 100 miles SE of Chicago and 100 miles N of Indianapolis.

Set-up, launch and Friday registration at the Rowing Center. Saturday registration, breakfast and lunch are located at the Naval Building.

Facilities: Launching via hoist; bring your bridle. Wet-Sail from the Naval Building Pier, stern line required. In addition, the bay is shallow and the bottom is good holding for anchors. Bring your own anchor and float.
